



Steps for MEANINGFUL MEDICATION REVIEWS

REMINDER: Hospitalists & Nurses can request assistance from Pharmacists for Med Review

- 1** Review current Medications with admitted Patient for **Accuracy**
 - Document *Best Possible Medication History (BPMH)* using MediNet, if there are significant discrepancies in the original med history
- 2** Review **New Medications** added in Hospital (regularly scheduled, PRNs & ON HOLD meds)
- 3** Prior to discharge, review ALL medications and prepare patient's **Discharge Prescription**

Physician responsible for Discharge Rx

 - Note *NEW* meds, *CHANGED* doses, and *DISCONTINUED* meds with rationale
- 4** Prepare **Medication Calendar** for the Patient & Family to identify NEW medications and CHANGED dose
- 5** For Continuity of Care, fax the **Discharge Prescription** to Community Pharmacy, **Family Physician**, & relevant Specialists
