

Steps for

MEANINGFUL MEDICATION REVIEWS

REMINDER: Hospitalists & Nurses can request assistance from Pharmacists for Med Review

Review current Medications with admitted Patient for

- Accuracy
 - Document Best Possible Medication History (**BPMH**) using MediNet, if there are significant discrepancies in the original med history
- Review **New Medications** added in Hospital (regularly scheduled, PRNs & ON HOLD meds)
 - Prior to discharge, review ALL medications and prepare patient's **Discharge Prescription**

Physician responsible for Discharge Rx

- Note NEW meds, CHANGED doses, and DISCONTINUED meds with rationale
- Prepare **Medication Calendar** for the Patient & Family to identify NEW medications and CHANGED dose
