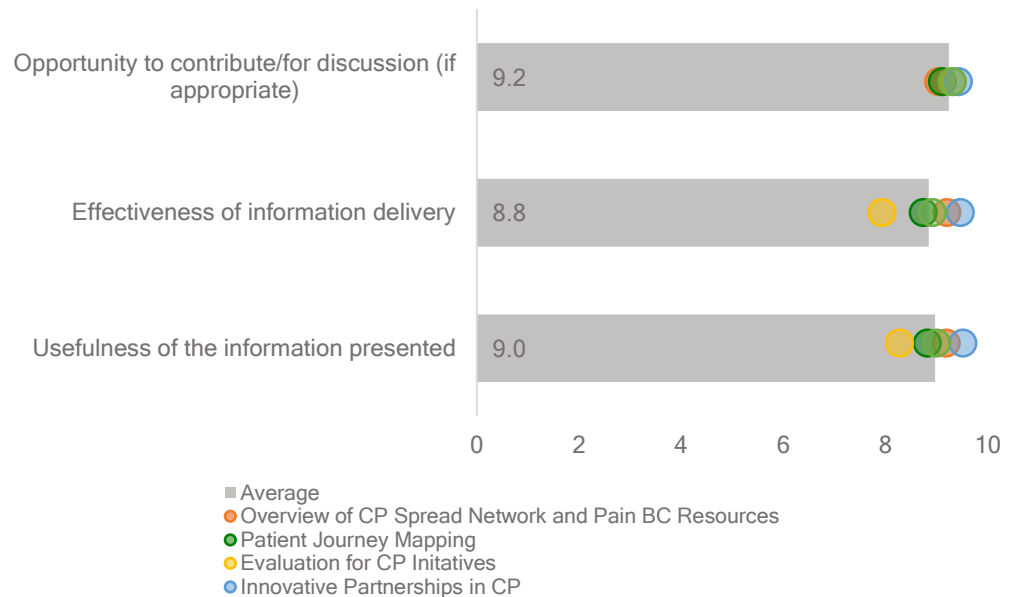

- Usefulness of the information presented: 9.0/10

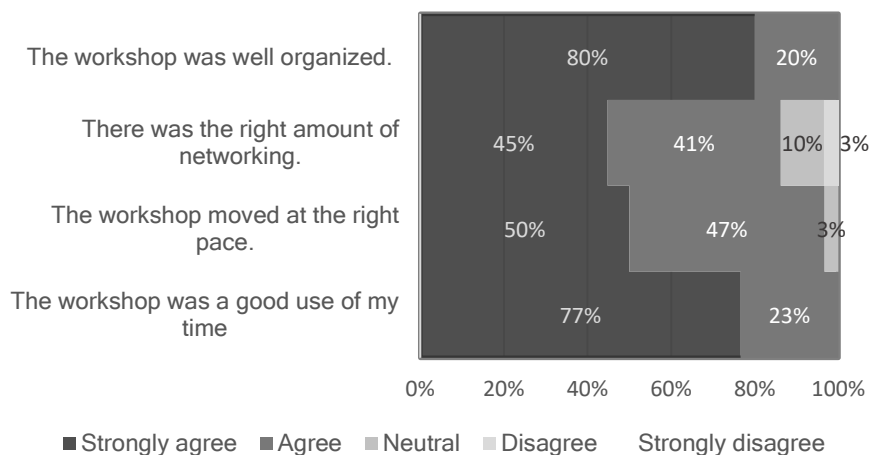
Please rate the following on a scale of 1-10 (10 being the best)
