

Shared Care call for proposals: Cancer Care Projects

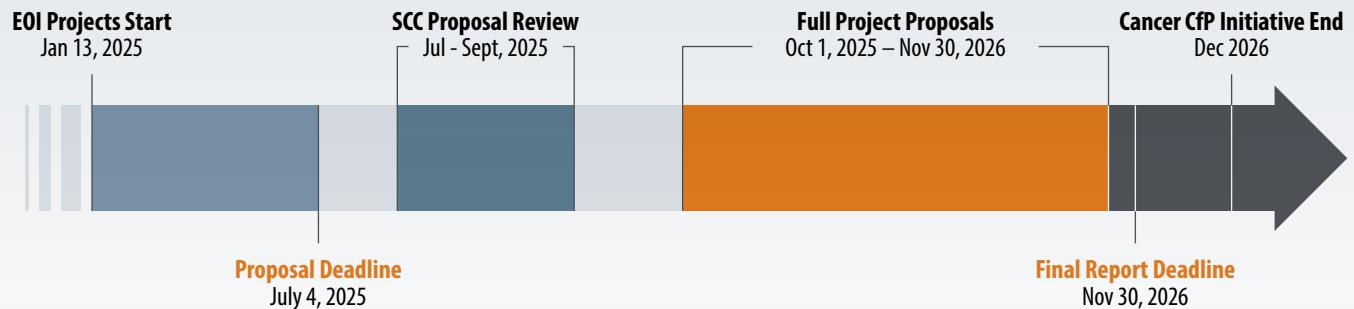
Purpose

The Shared Care Committee (SCC) has provided funding to support physician leadership in innovative projects that advance BC's 10-Year Cancer Action Plan and the SCC's priority to enhance cancer care. The SCC, Ministry of Health (MoH), Provincial Health Services Authority (PHSA), and BC Cancer have collaborated to develop priorities and implement the call for proposals initiative.

15

Currently, **15 active projects** are funded across 5 Health Authorities: VCH, FHA, PHSA, IHA, and IH.

Timeline



Governance

- An Advisory Committee (AC) with representatives from BC Cancer Operations, medical staff associations, Shared Care, PHSA, the Ministry of Health, and patient partners provides oversight for this initiative.
- They ensure projects align with the Cancer Action Plan and connect project teams with clinical and health system leaders and resources across BC Cancer and the health authorities.
- The SCC governs and partners with PHSA's Medical Staff Quality team to provide centralized project management and quality improvement expertise.

Priority Areas

Projects are aligned with the following priorities:



Recruitment and retention of medical staff (both primary care and specialist) in oncology



Improve diagnostic pathways



Transitions in care, including unattached patients and Community Oncology Networks



Pain and symptom management



All funded projects must concentrate on the management of both attached and unattached patients
